**RECOMMENDATIONS AND PROPOSALS**

1. The following existing features of Teerelton village should be protected and enhanced to create a unique and picturesque village in the future:
  - Copses of mature trees on approach to village.
  - Built edge to street in the village core should be maintained and reinforced
  - Expansive views across rural landscape to the north west.
2. The following proposals seek to develop a neat, legible, sustainable, unique and safe village core environment in Teerelton:
  - new footpaths for connection of the main community facilities within the village ie shop and school.
  - entrance gateway features on approach to the village including rumble strips, avenue tree planting and decorative signage.
  - Clear definition of footpaths and shared surface in the core of the village to prioritise pedestrian movement and create a central focus for the surrounding area.
  - Create a clear hierarchy of roadways to make crossroads safer for pedestrians and vehicles.
  - Open space associated with memorial stone that protects the views to the north west.
  - Infill development to encourage centralised growth that defines a clear village core
  - Screen unsightly co op super store from village core with climbers and specimen trees

**① PROPOSED ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS**

- Textured surface at crossroads to make drivers aware of the village core.
- Widening of footpaths and pedestrian zones to form a hierarchy of roadways in village core
- Wide footpaths to encourage outdoor eating and an active street scape.
- Formalised parking
- Screening of Co op with climbers and tree planting
- Maintaining outward looking views within village core to the north west
